<b>Carnaval de Estepona</b>	February 14 – 15	Local parades, costumes, and musical performances (chirigotas).
<b>Semana Santa</b>	March 29 – April 5	Holy Week with traditional religious processions through the old town.
<b>San Isidro Labrador</b>	May 15 (Main day)	Feast of the patron saint of farmers. Includes a pilgrimage (Romería) and a popular street fair.
<b>San Juan Bonfires</b>	June 23 – 24	Celebration of the summer solstice with large bonfires and parties on the beach at midnight.
<b>Estepona Grand Fair</b>	July 7 – 12	The "Feria Mayor". A week of music, dancing, horse parades, and attractions at the Recinto Ferial.
<b>Virgen del Carmen</b>	July 16	Maritime procession where the statue of the Virgin is taken out to sea by fishing boats.
<b>Virgen de los Remedios</b>	August 15	Procession through the streets in honor of the ancient patroness of the town.
<b>Christmas Market</b>	December – January	Seasonal stalls and light displays in the city center.
